Welcome to the Water and Environment Technology Conference 2013 (WET2013), held in Tokyo, Japan on the 15th-16th June 2013. The conference focuses on topics related to water environment, and provides a hybrid-type forum to promote exchange of information, ideas and knowledge among scientists, engineers and students. Scientific committee encourages participants to submit their manuscripts to the Journal of Water and Environment Technology (JWET), which is an official journal of the Japan Society on Water Environment (JSWE). Manuscripts submitted to JWET are subjected to the normal peer-review process.

CONFERENCE TOPICS

Conference topics include, but are not limited to the following:

- Analysis of water and environment quality
- Modeling of water and environment
- Treatment of water and wastewater
- Restoration of contaminated environment
- Hazardous chemicals and waste management
- Public health and risk assessment
- Environmental education and training
- Water reclamation

REGISTRATION

On-line registration was available for participants and speakers on the WET2013 website (<http://www.jswe.or.jp/extra/wet2013/>) by 31st May 2013 for early-bird registration. The registration fee is collected by cash (in Japanese Yen) on site. On site registration can be available after June 1st. The fee covers participation to all scientific sessions and the abstract proceedings. The conference banquet is free of charge for all registered participants. Students are required to show their student ID at the registration desk, otherwise the full registration fee is charged.

INSTRUCTION FOR PRESENTERS

All presenters are asked to introduce your posters in oral introduction session prior to the poster viewing sessions.

1. Oral introduction presentation

- a) Prepare your presentation slides with Microsoft Powerpoint. Laptop Windows PCs equipped with Office 2010 are prepared in the presentation rooms. Macintosh PC is not available.
- b) Bring your presentation slide file by USB flash memory. We strongly recommend you to bring your file in more than one USB flash memories as a precaution.
- c) The file name should be your presentation number and your name. For example, if my presentation number is 1A-18, then the file name must be "1A-18kurisu".
- d) Strictly keep presentation time shorter than 4 (four) minutes. Session chair may interrupt your presentation after 4 minutes.
- e) All the questions and discussion should be made at the poster viewing session. No time for questions and discussion in the oral presentation.
- f) Install your presentation files to the PC in the session room at earliest occasion, at least by 5 minutes before your session starts. Ask WET2013 staffs in the session room for assistance.

2. Poster viewing session

- a) Size of the poster board is 153 cm height and 90 cm width. Prepare your poster to fit in the poster board.
- b) Push pins is available at the poster session floor.
- c) Put/remove your poster according to the following schedule;

For presenters on 15th

Put your poster between 12 pm (noon) and 1 pm on 15th (1st day)

Remove your poster right after the second session ends (17:50).

For presenters on 16th

Put your poster after the second poster session (after 17:50) on 15th, or between 8 am and 9 am on 16th (2nd day)

Remove your poster by 2:30 pm

Note that remaining poster after the designated time will be removed and disposed by the WET2013 staffs.
