#### **PAPER REVIEWING**

The WET2016 Scientific Committee will review abstracts and full papers based on their relevance, originality, technical content and significance to a broad audience. Each submission will be reviewed anonymously by at least two independent reviewers. Accepted abstracts will be published in the conference proceedings. Abstracts and papers of a genuinely commercial nature will be rejected.
